Here are some tips to getting your home looking its best and spotlight ready:

Things that should not be seen

- Cars in the driveway
- Shoes and coats
- Pets and their dishes, toys and beds
- Large storage bins and boxes
- Freestanding fans
- Shampoo bottles and toiletries
- Nothing hanging on the backs of doors
- Kleenex boxes and throw blankets
- Remote controls
- Children's toys (unless put away neatly)
- Brooms, shovels, garbage & recycling bins
- please remove all mats in house including bathroom.

Kitchen

- Counters should be as bare as possible
- Remove magnets & messages from fridge
- No tea towels
- Hide basket of mail & medications
- Make sure all dishes are put away

Bathrooms

- Close toilet lid and hid garbage can
- Remove all toiletries from sink area and shower/bath
- Open shower curtains

General

- Replace burnt out light bulbs
- DE-clutter and tidy up tables and shelves
- Turn ceiling fans off
- Make all beds Nicely
- Do not place things under furniture, the camera catches it every time!
